On July 11, 2021, in the final of the European Football Championship, England and Italy will meet. Despite the fact that England is the attorney of modern football, the athletes of this country have previously never won on European championships and did not even go to the final. In the world championships in England, only one victory, it happened in 1966. At the British Home Championships won the FRG team decisive match.

The first official match of the England national football was held on November 30, 1872. In the Glasgow at the Stadium, Hamilton, the ceresses of football generics met with Scotland national team. There was no view of the viewers of the goals scored in that meeting, the match was completed with a score of 0: 0. In the future, these teams often met each other, the matches were quite effective. With the same score 0: 0 rivals played only in 98 years.

In his first match, the British played the caps. Since 1886, a tradition has appeared to present such caps to the teams of the team after each match. The biggest victory in its history British won on February 18, 1882. On this day they met with the Ireland national team in Belfast. Match account 13: 0. The most productive football player in the team of England was the Oliver Waton from the Aston Villa Club. After his blows, the ball turned out to be in the grid of the Irish gate.

On April 17, 1937, England's football players first reached the field with numbers on T-shirts. It was the match of the home championship of the UK, in which the British met with their eternal rivals of the Scots.

The UK home championship is an interesting story. This is the oldest international football tournament, which was held 100 years from 1884 to 1984. The participants of the championship were teams of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. Only the number of points scored, excluding scored and missed balls, considered the tournament. In 1956, all four teams, the number of points was equal, respectively, all of them became winners.

For a long time, the British ignored the World Cups, debuting in this tournament only in 1950. Moreover, the debut turned out to be failed. In the group stage, England lost two matches of three. Especially hurt was defeated by the US team. The Americans were not among the favorites of the tournament, but the only ball in this meeting scored Joe Gayens, a student of Columbia University.

Stanley Matthews is a real legend of English football. He spent his first match for the national team

of his country in 1934, when a young athlete was only 19 years old. And the last time went out on the field in the England T-shirt on May 15, 1957 at the age of 42 and 102 days. Nobody from English footballers could not exceed this achievement, despite the fact that over 60 years have passed after this event.

On October 9, 1977, England's national team on the legendary stadium Wembley met with the Dutch. To the surprise of the audience, the Englishman Stan Bowles went to the game in different boots. On his left leg was Gola's boot, and on the right Adidas. For such an unusual advertising, he received 600 pounds of sterling: 200 from Gola and 400 from Adidas.

More than all the balls for the national team of England scored Wayne Rooney, speaking in its composition of 15 years from 2003 to 2018. During this time, he spent 120 matches, in which the rivals gates hit 53 times. He scored his first goal on October 6, 2003 at the Gate of the national team of Macedonia. At that time, the young forward was not even 18 years old. Rooney is the only English football player who managed to score over 50 goals, speaking for the English team.

Tommy Lawton played 23 games for the national team and scored 22 goals in them. He, of course, is significantly lagging behind Wayne Rooney by the number of heads, but is the owner of another unique achievement. On May 25, 1947, in the match with the Portugal national team, Lawton scored the ball after 17 seconds after the start of the game.

A 6-meter statue of Bobby Moore captain of England in the world of 1966 was installed next to Wembley Stadium in 2007. It was the only winning world championship for the British. As part of the national team Bobby Moore played 108 matches and was recognized as one of the best players in the history of the country. Moore died on February 24, 1993 at the age of 51 from cancer.

Football players of the USSR, the CIS and Russia met 15 times with England. Our athletes won 4 victories, the British 6. Another 5 meetings ended in a draw. The very first meeting took place on May 18, 1958 in Moscow. Despite the fact that the match was friendly, 102,000 spectators attended the stands of Luzhniki.
